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OFFICIAL & EXHIBITOR APPOINTED CONTRACTORS

OFFICIAL SERVICE CONTRACTORS

Show Management, acting on behalf of all Exhibitors and in the best interest of the exposition, has appointed Official Service Contractors to perform and provide necessary services and equipment. Official Service Contractors are appointed to:

- Insure the orderly and efficient installation and removal of the overall exposition.
- Assure the distribution of labor to all Exhibitors according to need.
- Provide sufficient labor to satisfy the requirements of Exhibitors and for the exposition itself.
- See that the proper type and limits of insurance are in force, and
- avoid any conflict with local union and/or exhibit hall regulations.

The Official Service Contractors will provide all trade show services, including labor. Exceptions are:

- a. Supervision may be provided by the Exhibitor.
- b. The Exhibitor may appoint an exhibit installation contractor or display builder.

EXHIBITOR APPOINTED CONTRACTORS

Exhibitors may employ the service of independent contractors to install and dismantle their display, providing the Exhibitor and the installation and dismantling contractor comply with the following requirements:

1. The Exhibitor must notify Fun Factory Events (FFE) in writing of the intention to utilize an independent contractor no later than 30 days prior to the first move-in day, furnishing the name, address and telephone number of the firm.
2. The exhibitor shall provide evidence that the Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC) has a proper certificate of insurance with a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability coverage, including property damage, to FFE at least 10 days before the show opening.
3. The exposition floor, aisles, loading docks, service and storage areas will be under the control of the Official Service Contractor, FFE.
4. For services such as electrical, cleaning and material handling, no contractor other than the Official Service Contractors will be approved. This regulation is necessary of licensing, insurance and work done on equipment and facilities owned by parties other than the Exhibitor. Exhibitors shall provide only the material and equipment they own and is to be used in their exhibit space.
5. The EAC to be used by the exhibitor must provide a certificate of insurance with at least the following limits:
 - a. Comprehensive General Liability not less than \$1,000,000 with respect to injuries to any one person in an occurrence.
 - b. \$2,000,000 with respect to injuries to more than one person in any occurrence.
 - c. Workers' Compensation Insurance, including employee liability coverage, in a minimum amount not less than \$1,000,000 of individual and/or aggregate coverage.
 - d. FFE must be named as additional insured.
6. The Exhibitor Appointed Contractor:
 - a. Must agree to abide by all rules and regulations of the show, including all union rules and regulations.
 - b. Must have all business licenses, permits and Worker's Compensation Insurance required by the State and City governments and the convention facility management prior to commencing work and shall provide FFE with evidence of compliance.
 - c. Will share with FFE all reasonable costs related to its operation, including overtime pay for stewards, restoration of exhibit space to its initial condition, etc.
 - d. Must furnish Show Management and FFE with the names of all on-site employees who will be working on the exposition floor and see that they have and wear at all times necessary identification badges as determined by Show Management.
 - e. Shall be prepared to show evidence that it has a valid authorization from the Exhibitor for services. The EAC may not solicit business on the exhibit floor.
 - f. Must confine its operations to the exhibit area or its clients. No service desks, storage areas, or other work facilities will be located anywhere in the building. The show aisles and public space are not a part of the Exhibitor's booth space.
 - g. Shall provide, if requested, evidence to FFE it possesses applicable and current labor contracts and must comply with all labor agreements and practices. The EAC must not commit or allow to be committed by persons in its employment any acts that could lead to work stoppages, strikes or labor problems.
 - h. Must coordinate all of its activities with FFE.
7. All information must be received in the FFE office no later than 30 days prior to the show.

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PAYMENT & LABOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions set forth below become a part of the contractual agreement between Fun Factory Events and you, the EXHIBITOR. Acceptance of said terms and conditions will be construed when any of the following conditions are met:

- **WHEN THE METHOD OF PAYMENT FORM IS SIGNED; OR**
- **WHEN AN ORDER FOR LABOR, SERVICES AND/OR RENTAL EQUIPMENT IS PLACED BY AN EXHIBITOR WITH FUN FACTORY DECORATIONS & SPECIAL EVENTS; OR**
- **WHEN WORK IS PERFORMED ON BEHALF OF EXHIBITOR BY LABOR SECURED THROUGH FUN FACTORY DECORATIONS & SPECIAL EVENTS.**

DEFINITIONS: The name "Fun Factory Events" shall be construed within the meaning of this contract as Fun Factory Events (FFE), also dba "Fun Factory Decorations & Special Events", and/or its employees, officers, directors, agents and assigns, affiliated companies and related entities including but not limited to any subcontractors FFE may appoint. The term EXHIBITOR shall be construed within the meaning of this contract as the EXHIBITOR and/or its employees, agents, representatives, and/or any Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (E.A.C.).

PAYMENT TERMS: Full payment, including any applicable tax, is due in advance or at show site. All payments must be in U.S. funds and all checks must be drawn on a U.S. or Canadian bank. The term "U.S. Funds" must be pre-printed on all Canadian checks. Orders received without advance payment or after the deadline date will incur additional {After Deadline} charges as indicated on each order form. All materials and equipment are on a rental basis for the duration of the show or event and remain the property of FFE except where specifically identified as a sale. All FFE rentals include delivery, installation and removal from EXHIBITOR'S booth. In case of cancellation, a one-hour "per person, per hour" charge will be applied to all labor orders that are not cancelled in writing at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled start time. If services have already been provided at the time of cancellation, a 30% restocking fee will be applied to all FFE rental items with the exception of Plush Carpet, Custom-Cut Carpet, Signs and any other custom-order items, which will remain 100% of the original charge. It is the EXHIBITOR'S responsibility to advise FFE Exhibitor Services personnel of any problem with any order and to check invoices for accuracy prior to the close of the exhibit. If EXHIBITOR is exempt from payment of sales tax, FFE requires an exemption certificate for the State of Texas. Resale certificates are not valid unless EXHIBITOR is rebilling these charges to its customers. For International EXHIBITORS, FFE requires 100% prepayment of advance orders and any other orders or services placed at show site must be paid at the show. For all others, should there be any pre-approved unpaid balance after the close of the show, terms will be net, due and payable in GARLAND, TEXAS upon receipt of invoice. Effective 30 days after invoice date, any unpaid balance will bear a FINANCE CHARGE at the lesser of the maximum rate allowed by applicable law, or 1.5% per month, which is an ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE of 18%, and future orders will be on a pre-paid basis only. If any finance charge hereunder exceeds the maximum rate allowed by applicable law, the finance charge will automatically be reduced to the maximum rate allowed, and any excess finance charge received by FFE shall either be applied to reduce the principal unpaid balance or refunded to the payer. These payment terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS. In the event of any dispute between EXHIBITOR and FFE relative to any loss, damage or claim, such EXHIBITOR shall not be entitled to and shall not withhold payment, or any partial payment, due to FFE for its services, as an offset against the amount of any alleged loss or damage. Any claim against FFE shall be considered a separate transaction and shall be resolved on its own merits. FFE reserves the right to charge EXHIBITOR for the difference between the EXHIBITOR'S estimate of charges and the actual charges incurred by EXHIBITOR, or for any charges that FFE may be obligated to pay on behalf of EXHIBITOR, including without limitation, any shipping charges.

OPTION A: LABOR PROVIDED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF FFD&SE

RESPONSIBILITIES: FFE shall be responsible for the performance of labor provided under this option. FFE cannot assume responsibility for any acts of, or loss to, parties and/or other contracting firms not under FFE's direct supervision and control. In no event shall FFE be liable for loss or damage caused by delay in labor beginning work when EXHIBITOR requests labor to begin later than the start of the working day. FFE shall not be responsible for loss, delay or damage due to strike, lockouts, and/or work stoppages, or other causes beyond FFE's reasonable control.

INDEMNIFICATION: FFE agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend EXHIBITOR from and against any and all demands, claims, causes of actions, fines, penalties, damages, liabilities, judgments and expenses (including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and investigation costs) for bodily injury to FFE employees, or property damage arising out of work performed by labor provided by and supervised by FFE, except when EXHIBITOR exercises direction and/or control over the work being performed.

OPTION B: LABOR PROVIDED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF EXHIBITOR

RESPONSIBILITIES: EXHIBITOR shall be responsible for the performance of labor provided under this section. It is the responsibility of EXHIBITOR to supervise labor secured through FFE in a reasonable manner as to prevent bodily injury and/or property damage and also to direct them to work in a manner that is in compliance with FFE Safe Work Rules and/or Federal, State, County and Local ordinances, rules and/or regulations, including but not limited to Show or Facility Management Rules and/or Regulations. It is the responsibility of EXHIBITOR to check in with the Service Desk to pick up labor and to return to the Service desk to release labor when the work is completed.

INDEMNIFICATION: EXHIBITOR agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend FFE from and against any and all demands, claims, causes of action, fines, penalties, damages, liabilities, judgments and expenses (including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and investigation costs) for bodily injury, including any injury to FFE employees, and/or property damage arising out of work performed by labor provided by FFE but supervised by EXHIBITOR. Further, EXHIBITOR'S indemnification of FFE includes any and all violations of Federal, State, County or Local ordinances, "Show Regulations and/or Rules" as published and/or set forth by Facility or Show Management, and/or directing labor provided by FFE to work in a manner that violates any of the above rules, regulations, and/or ordinances.

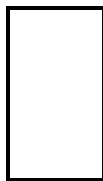

MATERIAL HANDLING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Acceptance of said terms and conditions will be construed when any of the following conditions are met:

- **THE MATERIAL HANDLING SERVICE AGREEMENT IS SIGNED; OR**
- **WHEN EXHIBITOR'S MATERIALS ARE DELIVERED TO FFE'S WAREHOUSE OR TO A SHOW/EXPOSITION SITE FOR WHICH FUN FACTORY DECORATIONS & SPECIAL EVENTS IS THE OFFICIAL CONTRACTOR; OR**
- **WHEN AN ORDER FOR LABOR AND/OR RENTAL EQUIPMENT IS PLACED BY AN EXHIBITOR WITH FFE.**

1. **DEFINITION:** For all purposes of this contract, "Fun Factory Events" (FFE), also dba as "Fun Factory Decorations & Special Events", means the company, its employees, officers, directors, agents, assigns, affiliated companies and related entities including but not limited to any subcontractors FFE may appoint. The term "EXHIBITOR" means the Exhibitor, its employees, agents, representatives and any Exhibitor Appointed Contractors (EAC). Further, the EXHIBITOR is in fact the "Shipper" for all purposes and circumstances notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary.
2. **PACKAGING & CRATES:** FFE shall not be responsible for damage to loose, uncrated materials, pad-wrapped or shrink-wrapped materials, glass breakage, concealed damage, carpets in bags or poly, or materials improperly packed. FFE shall not be responsible for crates and packaging which are unsuitable for handling, in poor condition, or have prior damage. Crates and packaging should be of a design to adequately protect contents for handling by forklift and similar means.
3. **EMPTY CONTAINERS:** Empty container labels will be available at the show site service desk. Affixing labels to the containers is the sole responsibility of EXHIBITOR or his representative. All previous labels must be removed or obliterated. FFE assumes no responsibility for: error in the above procedures; removal of containers with old empty labels & without FFE labels; or improper information on empty labels. FFE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO CRATES AND CONTAINERS OR THEIR CONTENTS WHILE SAID ITEMS ARE IN EMPTY STORAGE.
4. **INBOUND SHIPMENTS:** Consistent with trade show industry practices, there may be a lapse of time between the delivery of shipment(s) to the booth and the arrival of Exhibitor or his representative, and *during such time the materials will be left unattended*. FFE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, THEFT OR DISAPPEARANCE OF EXHIBITOR'S MATERIALS AFTER SAME HAVE BEEN DELIVERED TO EXHIBITOR'S BOOTH AT SHOW SITE. FFE highly recommends the securing of security services from Facility or Show Management.
5. **OUTBOUND SHIPMENTS:** Consistent with trade show industry practices, there may be a lapse of time between the completion of packing and the actual pickup of materials from the booths for loading onto a carrier and *during such time the materials will be left unattended*. FFE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, THEFT OR DISAPPEARANCE OF EXHIBITOR'S MATERIALS BEFORE SAME HAVE BEEN PICKED UP FOR RELOADING AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE EVENT. FFE highly recommends the securing of security services from Facility or Show Management. All Material Handling Agreements submitted to FFE by EXHIBITOR will be checked at the time of pickup from the booth and corrections will be made where discrepancies exist between the quantities of items listed by EXHIBITOR and the actual count of such items in the booth at the time of pickup.
6. **FFD&SE'S RESPONSIBILITIES:** FFE shall be responsible only for those services which it directly provides. FFE assumes no responsibility for any persons, parties or other contracting firms not under FFD&SE direct supervision and control. FFE shall not be responsible for loss, delay or damage due to strike, lockouts, work stoppages, natural elements, vandalism, acts of God, civil disturbances, power failures, explosions, acts of terrorism or war, other causes beyond FFE'S reasonable control, nor for ordinary wear & tear in the handling of materials.
7. **INSURANCE:** It is understood that FFE is not an insurer. Insurance on exhibit materials, if any, shall be obtained by EXHIBITOR in amounts and for perils determined by EXHIBITOR. EXHIBITOR agrees to provide FFE with a release of subrogation to the extent of any insurance settlement received.
8. **DECLARED VALUE:** Declared value is available only on AIR SHIPMENTS. The value per pound for applying valuation charges shall be determined by dividing the Shipper's declared value for carriage by the actual weight of the shipment.
 - (a) GROUND SHIPMENTS: No Declared Value is available for ground shipments. If the shipper elects to declare a value, they must ship by air.
 - (b) Notwithstanding the above limitations, all shipments, domestic and international, containing the following items of extraordinary value are limited to a maximum declared value of \$500.00 (USD):
 1. Artworks and objects of art, namely original paintings, drawings, etchings, water colors, tapestries or sculptures.
 2. Clocks, jewelry, including costume jewelry, furs and fur trimmed clothing.
 3. Personal effects, including without limitation papers and documents.
 - (c) Liability for damage to shipments containing glass shall be limited to \$50.00 (USD). Shipments with a declared value exceeding \$50.00 (USD) will not be accepted. If inadvertently accepted, liability will be limited to \$50.00 (USD). Glass shipments include without limitation windshields, plate glass, ceramics, chinaware and light bulbs.
 - (d) Any declared value in excess of the maximums allowed herein is null and void and the acceptance by us for carriage of any shipment with a declared value in excess of the allowed maximums does not constitute a waiver of these maximums.
9. **CLAIM(S) FOR LOSS.** Claims for loss or damage must be filed within nine (9) months after the delivery of the property, except that claims for failure to make delivery must be filed nine (9) months after a reasonable time for delivery has elapsed. In no event shall a suit or action be brought against FFE more than two (2) years and one day from the day when written notice is given by FFE to EXHIBITOR that the claim is disallowed. Receipt of shipment by consignee or the consignor's agent without written notification of damage or loss will be prima facie evidence that the shipment was delivered in good condition.
 - (a) PAYMENT FOR SERVICES MAY NOT BE WITHHELD. In the events of any dispute between the EXHIBITOR and FFE relative to any loss, damage or claim such EXHIBITOR shall not be entitled to and shall not withhold payment, or any partial payment, due to FFE for its services, as an offset against the amount of any alleged loss or damage.
 - (b) MAXIMUM RECOVERY. If found liable for any loss, FFE's sole and exclusive MAXIMUM liability for loss or damage to EXHIBITOR'S materials and EXHIBITOR'S sole and exclusive remedy is limited to \$.50 per pound per article with a maximum liability of \$100.00 per item, or \$1,500.00 per shipment, whichever is less, unless shipper makes a declaration of value in the space designated on the Material Handling Agreement and pays the appropriate valuation charge. When a declaration is made, liability shall in no event exceed the declared value of the shipment. DECLARED VALUE AMOUNTS APPLY ONLY TO THE AIR SHIPMENT OF MATERIALS AND NOT TO OTHER SERVICES PROVIDED BY FFE INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, MATERIAL HANDLING SERVICES.
 - (c) BREACH OF CONTRACT AND/OR NEGLIGENCE ONLY. FFE'S liability shall be limited to any loss or damage which results solely from FFD&SE'S NEGLIGENCE in the actual physical handling of the items compromising EXHIBITOR'S shipment(s) OR which results from BREACH OF THIS CONTRACT and not for any other type of loss or damage. In no event shall FFE be liable to the EXHIBITOR or to any other party for special, collateral, exemplary, indirect, incidental or consequential damages, whether such damages occur either prior or subsequent to, or are alleged as a result of tortious conduct, failure of the equipment or services of FFE or provisions of this agreement regardless of the form of action, whether in contract or in tort, including strict liability and negligence, even if FFE has been advised or has notice of the possibility of such damages, or for any damages caused by EXHIBITOR'S responsibilities. Such excluded damages include but are not limited to loss of profile, loss of use or interruption of business, or other consequential or indirect economic loss(es).
10. **JURISDICTION.** THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE CONSTRUED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS WITHOUT GIVING EFFECT TO ITS CONFLICT OF LAWS RULES, EXCLUSIVE VENUE FOR ALL DISPUTES ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS CONTRACT SHALL RESIDE IN A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS.
11. **INDEMNIFICATION.** EXHIBITOR agrees to indemnify, forever hold harmless and defend FFE, its employees, directors, officers and agents from and against any and all demands, claims, causes of action, fines, penalties, damages (including consequential), liabilities, judgments, and expenses (including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and investigation cost(s) on account of personal injury, death, or damage to or loss of property or profits arising out of, or contributed to, by any of the following: EXHIBITOR'S negligent supervision of any labor secured through FFE, or the negligent supervision of such labor by any of EXHIBITOR'S employees, agents, representatives, customers, invitees and/or any EAC. EXHIBITOR'S negligence, willful misconduct, or deliberate act, or the negligence, willful misconduct, or deliberate act of EXHIBITOR'S employees, agents, representatives, customers, invitees and/or any EAC at the show or exposition to which this contract relates. EXHIBITOR'S violation of Federal, State, County or Local ordinances or the violation of Show Regulations and/or Rules as published and set forth by Facility and/or Show Management. EXHIBITOR'S inclusion of illegal substances, hazardous materials or waste in any shipments placed with FFE and for the violation of the representations and warranties made regarding hazardous materials as shown on the Material Handling Agreement.
12. **MISCELLANEOUS.** EXHIBITOR, waives and releases all claims against FFE, its employees, agents, officers and directors, with respect to all matters for which FFE has disclaimed liability pursuant to the provisions of this contract. The EXHIBITOR acknowledges that he or she has read, understands and agrees to the provisions herein.

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FIRE DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS

The information contained in this brief outline does not by any means cover completely the ordinances and regulations contained in the City of Dallas Fire Code, but it does provide the basic rules governing concessions, exhibits and shows in any building open to the public.

1. Submit plans to the fire marshal before erecting a structure as a display inside an exhibit building unless the decorative and construction materials are non-combustible or flameproof.
2. All exit doors serving any occupied area of the building must remain unlocked, unobstructed and in proper operating condition; exit signs must function properly and be visible from all areas.
3. All curtains, drapes or decorations must be non-combustible or flameproof.
4. Any merchandise or material attached to drapes or table skirts must be non-combustible or flameproof.
5. Fire extinguishing equipment needs will be determined by the fire marshal and any such equipment must remain visible and accessible.
6. Automotive vehicles and equipment may be displayed if:
 - a. There is not more than 5 gallons of fuel or the minimum amount for positioning.
 - b. Fuel tanks are locked and sealed.
 - c. Battery cables are disconnected.
 - d. Ignition keys are removed and at display location.
 - e. Vehicle operation is limited to brief parade type displays specifically approved by the fire marshal.
7. The storage of combustible shipping containers must be confined to areas approved by the fire marshal.
8. The use, display or storage of LPG, flammable liquid or flammable gas must be approved by the fire marshal in writing.
9. NO SMOKING BY ORDER OF THE FIRE MARSHAL signs must be posted and maintained in areas so designated by the fire marshal.
10. The use of open flames, burning or smoke-emitting materials as part of an act, display or show is prohibited.
11. Combustible waste is to be collected as it accumulates and be stored in non-combustible, covered containers which are emptied at least once each day.
12. The use of welding and cutting equipment for demonstration purposes must be by permit from the fire marshal.
13. The use of compressed gas cylinders must be approved by the fire marshal and cylinders must be firmly secured in an upright position.
14. All commercial type cooking appliances shall be equipped with ventilation hoods and approved automatic extinguishing systems. All other cooking devices shall have adequate separation from combustible materials by spacing or non-combustible shielding.
15. The use of gas and any gas-fired appliances must be approved by the fire marshal; the use of salamander stoves is prohibited.
16. Sawdust and shavings shall be kept flameproof.
17. The storage of hay and straw must be approved by fire marshal.

These are Basic Rules which every exhibit must comply with prior to the scheduled opening.
